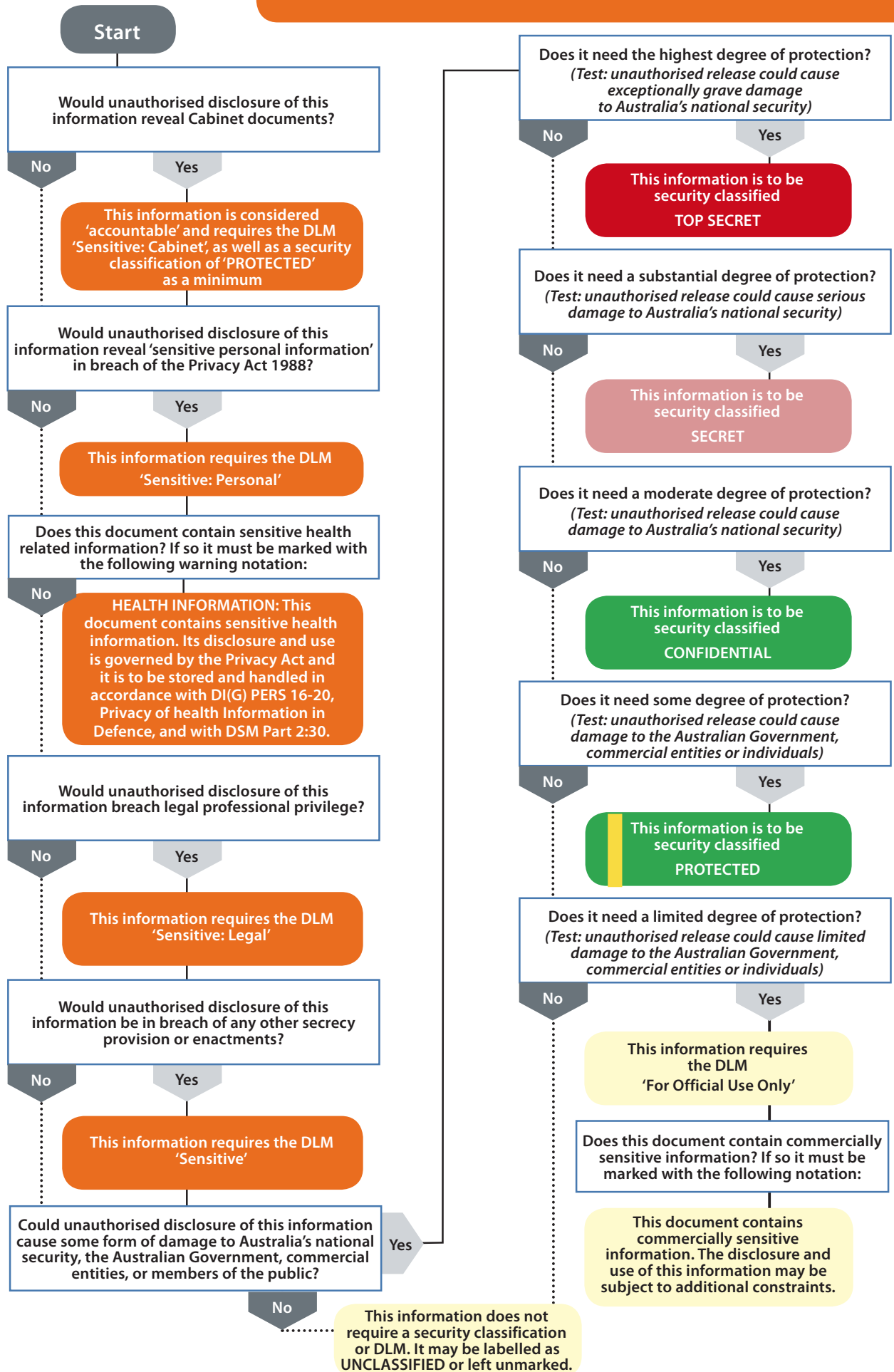




HOW TO SELECT AN APPROPRIATE PROTECTIVE MARKING





AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT SECURITY CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM - HOW TO APPLY DISSEMINATION LIMITING MARKERS (DLMS)

I used to protect an item with **CABINET-IN-CONFIDENCE**

Now I protect an equivalent item with **Sensitive:Cabinet**

If the information has no national security impacts eg building works, pay issues etc it can be classified as **PROTECTED**

I used to classify an item as **RESTRICTED**
(Security Classification)

Now I protect an equivalent item with **For Official Use Only (FOUO)**
(Dissemination Limiting Marker)

I used to protect an item with **X-IN-CONFIDENCE**
(eg –SECURITY-IN-CONFIDENCE, COMMERICAL-IN-CONFIDENCE, STAFF-IN-CONFIDENCE)
(Dissemination Limiting Marker)

Now I protect an equivalent item with **For Official Use Only (FOUO)**
(Dissemination Limiting Marker)

Include Dissemination warnings as appropriate.

I used to protect an item with **X-IN-CONFIDENCE**
(eg –MEDICAL-IN-CONFIDENCE OR LEGAL-IN-CONFIDENCE)
(Dissemination Limiting Marker)

Now I protect an equivalent item with **Sensitive, Sensitive: personal or Sensitive: legal**
(Dissemination Limiting Marker)

Include Dissemination warnings as appropriate.
